Serving Lunch and Evening Dinner, Wednesday to Sunday, the 2 AA Rosette Horseshoe Restaurant combines the skills of Head Chef Alistair Craig with the quality of the freshest, local produce to create a memorable culinary experience.

Alistair, formerly Senior Sous Chef at the Michelin starred Montagu Arms, scours the Scottish Borders for the best possible food suppliers and because the restaurant is small, the kitchen can welcome doorstep deliveries by local growers of first rate market garden produce.

The organic Whitmuir Farm just across the hills from Eddleston, organic Peelham Farm at Foulden, Dryhope Estate in the Yarrow Valley and Ettrick Valley Smokehouse are amongst the local food producers that our kitchen use.

We also have been developing our kitchen garden which sits behind the Lodge. With a south facing high stone wall to provide shelter and reflect heat and a land slope of nearly 45° this land provides a well draining sun trap for us to grow vegetables and herbs.



Eight lovely bedrooms have been created from the beautifully restored Victorian village school house which sits just behind the Horseshoe.

The bedrooms are rated 4 Gold Stars by the AA Guide; they all have en-suite showers, bathrobes, luxurious local handmade organic toiletries, mineral water, tea and coffee making trays with fresh milk, fresh fruit and homemade cake.

We have one Premier room which, rather than an en-suite shower has an en-suite bath with shower and a slightly larger bedroom complete with eating area.

Breakfast at the Horseshoe is a meal considered as important for us as dinner and we were delighted to receive in 2012 and again in 2013 an award from the AA Guide for our outstanding breakfasts.




The Horseshoe is located just 30 minutes south of Scotland's capital, just outside the market town of Peebles which boasts a wide selection of Independently owned shops.
